The John Brown House is one of the oldest and grandest houses in Providence. It was built in 1788 by John Brown, a merchant, patriot, politician, and slave trader. The Brown family was one of the wealthiest and most influential families of the day, and they had equally important visitors including George Washington and Abigail Adams. Today, visitors will experience what life was like in the 18th century, and learn how Providence became the city that it is today.

Activity: When he was a boy, George Washington wrote a list of Rules of Civility & Decent Behavior. Read a few of Washington's rules and decide if we still follow them today. What other rules are important?

1. Treat everyone with respect.
2. Do not start what you cannot finish. Keep your promises.
3. Kill no vermin or pests in the company of others.
4. Do not take so big a bite that you must chew with your mouth open.

The John Brown House es una de las casas más antiguas y grandes en Providence. Fue construida en 1788 por John Brown, un mercader, patriota, político y comerciante de esclavos. La familia Brown fue una de las familias más ricas e influyentes de esa época, y también recibían invitados igualmente importantes incluyendo a George Washington y Abigail Adams. Hoy en día, los visitantes experimentarán cómo era la vida en el siglo 18, y aprenderán cómo Providence se convirtió en la ciudad que es hoy.

Actividad: Cuando era niño, George Washington escribió una lista de Reglas de Civismo y Conducta Decorosa. Lee algunas de las reglas de Washington y decide si todavía las seguimos hoy en día. ¿Qué otras reglas son importantes?

1. Trata a todos con respeto
 2. No empieces lo que no puedas terminar. Cumple tus promesas
 3. No mates alimañas o plagas en la compañía de otros
 4. No te llesves un bocado tan grande a la boca que tengas que masticar con la boca abierto
