



Supplemental Educational Services (SES) 2011-2012

Parents, your child may qualify for FREE tutoring!

Extra help in reading, writing, math and English language proficiency.

To find out about SES and sign up, follow these simple steps.

STEP 1: Is your child enrolled at one of these schools?

STEP 2: Does your child qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch AND have you returned your child's Meal Benefit Form to your child's school?

IF YOU ANSWERED "YES" TO STEP 1 AND STEP 2, PROCEED TO STEP 3

STEP 3: Pick a tutoring provider.

Review the attached list of tutoring providers that have been approved by the Rhode Island Department of Education. It is your choice to select any provider on this list—the one that best meets your child's academic needs. Note: There will be an SES Parent Information Night and Provider Fair on October 4 at Central High School, 70 Fricker Street, from 6-8 PM. You will be able to meet the tutoring providers in-person at this event

STEP 4: Apply.

Fill in the attached application form, and select your first, second and third choice tutoring providers for your child.

Return the application to your child's school by October 11, 2011.

- If more students apply than there is room for, priority will be given to students with the greatest academic need.
➤ Parents of students receiving services will receive phone calls from providers in November and December.
➤ Tutoring will start in January.
