



Part-Time Positions Available for Summer 2010 and School Year 2010-2011

Rhode Island Teaching Fellows (RITF) is currently seeking **Fellow Advisors** for summer 2010 as well as part-time **Seminar Leaders** for the 2010-2011 school year. Applying for a position is your opportunity to take on a leadership role, develop yourself professionally, and to contribute to the training of new teachers for RI's high-needs schools. The Rhode Island Teaching Fellows program is dedicated to recruiting, training and certifying high-quality individuals focused on impacting student achievement in our state. Teachers in our program (typically known as "Teaching Fellows") go through a rigorous selection process and summer training institute, before beginning teaching in fall 2010. Most Fellows do not have formal teaching experience, but all have a demonstrated record of past success, subject-matter knowledge, and a commitment to working in our schools.

Fellow Advisors (FAs) – Math and Science

The Fellow Advisors (FAs) guide Fellows through their Summer Training Institute, working with a group of approximately 10-20 Fellows. FAs will observe Fellows in their summer school classrooms, lead *Teaching for Student Achievement* (TfSA) curriculum sessions for Fellows, and ensure that Fellows are learning to set high academic goals for their students. FAs are crucial to our mission of providing high-quality teachers to teach in high-need positions throughout Rhode Island. Some qualifications include:

- At least two years experience teaching **middle school or secondary math or science**, preferably in an urban district
- Comfortable giving and receiving constructive feedback
- A record of achievement leading both children and adults

FAs will attend training sessions on April 29, May 8, and May 22. This position will require a part-time commitment through June and will be full-time from July to mid-August, with a follow-up curriculum session in September. **The stipend for this position is \$6,000.**

Seminar Leaders (SLs) – Math, Science, English Language Arts and Elementary

The Seminar Leader position offers experienced teachers the opportunity to formally train and support new teachers during their first year of teaching. Our *Teaching for Results* (TfR) curriculum has been developed specifically to help participants combine content knowledge with data-driven instruction in order to produce significant gains in student achievement. TfR Seminars meet two evenings a month for three-hour sessions. There are 16 sessions total from September 2010-May 2011, all of which are typically held in the Seminar Leader's classroom. Some qualifications include:

- At least three years experience teaching **elementary grades, middle school or secondary math, science or English Language Arts**, preferably in an urban school district
- Demonstrate past success in facilitating professional development or workshops for adult learners
- Have strong background in data collection and tracking

SLs will attend training sessions during summer 2010 and work part-time from September 2010 – June 2011. **The stipend for this position is \$4500.**
