



Third Grade Homework Policy

Homework will be assigned on a daily basis depending upon the skills needing reinforcement from classroom lessons. Third grade students need a homework folder to keep their assignments. Students have a daily assignment log to help them remain organized and remember what their assignments are. Please look this over and sign it each day.

The majority of their homework time will be spent reading! Students are expected to read a book, of their choosing, for 30 minutes Monday through Thursday evenings and at least once over the weekend. They are to record their nightly reading on their Reading Log each night. This will be checked daily.

On Fridays students will be tested on their weekly spelling/vocabulary words. Please help them study these words throughout the week. Additionally, students will be expected to learn third grade high frequency words.

Students should also practice their multiplication facts at home. We will create study aids to help with this important third grade skill. They need to be fluent up to their 10 x's tables.

Homework is a valuable aid that helps students make the most of their school experience. It reinforces what has been learned in class, prepares students for upcoming lessons, teaches responsibility, and helps students develop positive study habits.
