<b>Brown Pre-College STEM Program for Rising 9th graders</b>	The STEM for Rising 9th & 10th Graders is the only Brown Pre-College program that is available to middle school students. If your idea of summer fun is a deep-dive into the STEM fields, join other rising 9th and 10th graders who are as passionate about advancing their STEM skills as you are. This is a two-week residential program. Minimum eligibility requires that middle school applicants must be completing grade 8 and are age 14-15 by June 2019. Scholarship awards can cover from 20% - 100% of billable program costs (tuition, room & board).
