WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE FOR US THIS YEAR?

- RIDE and PPSD wants us to implement a soft roll out by only having students sign on to the platform and complete minimal tasks for the year.
- This is required by the state every year but since we were transitioning we have to make sure we complete the goals online through Naviance.
- Each grade will have different tasks
 - 9th -is required to input TWO academic goals (Short Term and Long Term)
 - Example of academic goal: I want to finish with good grades this semester and pass to the 10th grade.
 - Ejemplo de objetivo académico: Quiero terminar con buenas calificaciones este semestre y pasar al décimo grado.
 - 10th is required to input TWO career goals (Short Term and Long Term)
 - Example of career goal: I want to go on college board and research different career paths.
 - Ejemplo de objetivo profesional: Quiero ir a College Board y investigar diferentes caminos profesionales.
 - 11th is required to complete the 11th grade goals reflection
 - 12th- Senior Exit Survey
- Next year Naviance will fully be implemented for staff and students with more in depth training.
