HOW DO WE USE THE PASSPORT TO SUMMER LEARNING?

Tracking summer reading!

The front of the Passport has a reading pathway so your child can track their summer reading.

Color in a square each time your child reads at least 20 minutes or completes a literacy activity at a partner site.

Read at least 20 minutes a day for 40 days. Return the Passport to school in September.

HOW DO WE RECORD **MY CHILD'S READING ONLINE?**

Your library can help!

Record your child's reading days : 1. Go to

providence.readsquared.com. 2. Select Login (upper right corner)

3. Enter username: your child's first and last name; no spaces. 4. Enter password: your child's birth date written out in this format: January012005 (0 before single digits 1-9) 5. Change password. 6. Enter reading days!
