- 9. Is the district looking for a new program?

 Through our RFP process, the district reviews ELD and SLD curricular materials every three years.

 The current materials we are using for ELD and SLD have been in use for the past 3 years. We are looking to see if we will continue with our existing resources or potentially adopt new resources.
- 10. Can you please confirm the age ranges you are looking for materials for?

 ELD is K-12 and SLD will be available for grades K-9 next year with the goal of growing it to K-12 in the next few years.
- 11. For the ELD portion, are you able to clarify which age ranges/grade levels you are looking for?

- 12. Does the district intend to continue using Connect/Get Ready?

 This decision will be based on the vendor selected through the RFP process.
- a. Or would this RFP be for the secondary levels?

 The RFP is for ELD in K-12 and SLD in K-9 next year with the goal of growing it to K-12 in the next few years.
- 13. We have programs specifically targeted for ML/EL Learners, as well as programs specifically targeted for Spanish Language Learners. Are you looking for programs that address all the needs I mentioned here or just one or the other?

We are open to receiving bids from vendors that can support English Language Development OR Spanish Language Development OR both English and Spanish Language Development.

14. Can you provide clarification regarding the intended grade span/grade band(s) to be served? If all grades, K-12, will the district consider multiple awards (for example, a curriculum for K-5 and a different curriculum for 6-12)?

Yes. We will consider multiple awards. ELD curriculum is normally split by levels such as elementary K-5, middle school 6-8, and high school 9-12 (Spanish language development materials apply to grades K-9)

15. Regarding the first Required Qualification on page 12- "English Language Development (ELD) core or ancillary resources designed to develop the English language proficiency of Multilingual Learners" - can you clarify how the term "core" is intended? Are you looking for a core ELD program? Or could a proposed solution include ELA core with integration EL/ML support?

We are looking for a core ELD program to be used during a dedicated daily ELD block, outside of core ELA.

16. Regarding Required Qualification #10 on page 13- "A program that also supports the development of Multilingual Learner's L1 (Spanish, Arabic, Swahili, Portuguese, Haitian Creole, Khmer, Quiche, and/ or Pushto)" - can you clarify what is meant by "support the development" of the L1 - is this opportunities to use their home language? Explicit instruction in their home language? Everything translated in their home language?

For English Language Development materials, we are looking for a program that has scaffolds that are available to students in their native language. For example oral native language supports, or translated instructions in native language. For Spanish Language development we are looking for a program that will provide explicit instruction in Spanish language development. We do not want SLD materials to be a translation of English. We want our Spanish Language Learners to have access to authentic Spanish texts.

17. Is Providence Schools accepting proposals that do not cover all K-12 grade levels?
