This summer has been very busy at E-Cubed Academy preparing for the upcoming year. Our staff has attended training on new curriculum for English, Math, Science, Social Studies, World Languages, and Multilingual Learning. - Cell phones have become a major distraction and have greatly impacted learning. Our staff will be working with students on appropriate cell phone usage that supports instruction. To that end, if a phone isn't being used for a classroom task it is expected that phones will be away and silenced. If you need to reach your child, please contact the Main Office (401-456-0694) and we can get a message to your child.
- Students must earn all their required credits to graduate. A full list of required courses can be found in the student handbook. Students who are not passing are expected to make up work during our before school, after school, or Saturday Tutoring/Credit Recovery. These programs should start mid-September. More information will be forthcoming.

We look forward to working closely with you to support your child in being a successful student at E-Cubed Academy. We are asking that you complete the enclosed forms and return them to the school as soon as possible. We will be holding our Fall Parent Teacher Conference on Wednesday, October 26th from 4-6pm.
