
STUDENTS AND STAFF IN PRE K-12 SCHOOLS

Updated October 2022



You have symptoms consistent with COVID-19:

- Stay home
- Contact a healthcare provider
- · Get tested
- Return to school if test is negative and symptoms resolve.



You test positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status:

- Stay home and isolate for at least 5 days.
- Return to school on day 6 if you <u>do not</u> have symptoms and have been fever-free for at least 24 hours (without using fever reducing medication).
- If you **do** have symptoms on day 6, stay home and continue to isolate until your symptoms improve and you've been fever-free for at least 24 hours.
- Wear a well-fitting mask at school, at home and around others for an additional
 5 days
- Continue to wear a well-fitting mask at school and at home for the remainder
 of the 10-day period from symptom onset or COVID test date.

You have been identified as a close contact of a positive case...



... and you are vaccinated with no symptoms:

- · Attend school;
- Self monitor for 5 days; and
- · Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days.



...and you are not vaccinated with no symptoms:

- Attend school;
- Self monitor for 5 days; and
- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days.
