Medical Services

- Well-child checks and sick visits
- Adult care including physicals and sick visits
- Immunizations and laboratory testing, including rapid COVID, flu, strep
- Referrals to other services not available at the SMART clinic, such as x-rays, dental, and optometry
- Health education and promotion



Integrated Behavioral Health Services

- Behavioral health care including short-term assessment, treatment, and crisis intervention with individuals, families, and groups
- Referrals to other services not available at SMART clinic in conjunction with SMART physical health provider
- Mental health / social service education and outreach
