- 1. In what system are your current run/route data?
 - Edulog
- 2. Does the department have Fall 2019 student load data for existing runs/routes?
 - We have the 2019 route data. All of the 2020 runs are new based on the current transportation restrictions.
- 3. Does the department have a budget in mind for this project? Knowing a budget range would help us scope the project appropriately. A \$15,000 project would be scoped differently from a \$150,000 project.
 - The anticipated budget is approximately \$50,000 to \$75,000.
- 4. What are the goals for this project? In reviewing your current bell times, there is already a fair degree of uniformity. Is the goal to move secondary students to a later start time? Increase the amount of bus tiering by better spreading start times? Something else?
 - We would like to have several bell time scenarios modeled that allow us to optimize across several dimensions, including: 1) cost effectiveness (e.g., fewest number of runs/buses required); 2) on-time performance; and 3) student achievement/equity (e.g., moving older students to later start times; ensuring our highest need students have optimal bell times)
- 5. What portion of route transportation is outsourced? Does this project scope include reviewing options for transportation other than through bus contracting?
 - Routing is not currently outsourced.
- 6. What routing software is currently being used?
 - Edulog
- 7. How many runs/routes does the department operate normally for general education? How many for special education?
 - Routes are combined for all students. We currently have 386 runs.

- 8. Are special education runs/routes to be considered in the bell time analysis and future options?
 - Yes
- 9. How many tiers does the department currently have? Is the department looking to increase or decrease the number of tiers?
 - Due to current transportation restrictions we have moved to 3 tiers. Analysis should help determine proper number of tiers.
