Involvement in the Teen Board will consist of meeting attendance, virtual meeting participation, committee responsibilities, volunteering, fundraising, as well as other opportunities defined by the RMH Providence Staff / Advisors. All members must obtain permission from their parents/guardians prior to accepting any service obligations. Teens will be selected through an application process and MUST have applied by the application deadline in order to be considered.

Qualifications for the Teen Board:

1. Candidates MUST be beginning their sophomore, junior, or senior year in August of 2018.
2. Members must be able to guarantee a commitment of one (1) year of service starting fall of 2018.

Description of the Teen Board:

The Teen Board assists with the vision of the Ronald McDonald House of Providence to provide family-centered care to implement positive change within the community. The Teen Board is composed of local teenagers of Providence that will work as a team to raise funds for RMH Providence. There will be one monthly fundraiser that students are expected to facilitate.

About the House:

The Ronald McDonald House of Providence provides programs that directly improve the health and well-being of hospitalized children and their families. Our programs allow families to spend

additional time with a sick child, help ease financial burdens, provide a sense of normalcy and keep families together during times of medical crisis.
