Book - Single Author	Author Last Name, First Name. Title of Source. <i>Title of Container</i> , Other Contribtors, Version, Number, Publisher, Publication Date, Location.
	Coates, Ta-Nehisi. Between the World and Me. Thorndike P, 2016.
Citation with 2 Authors	Last name, First name, and First name Last name.
	Bagieu, Pénélope, and Montana Kane. Brazen: Rebel Ladies Who Rocked the World. First Second, 2018.
Citation with 3 or More Authors	List only the first author followed by et al.
	Wysocki, Anne Frances, et al.
Chapter or Essay in a Book	Last name, First name. "Title of Essay." <i>Title of Collection</i> , edited by Editor's Name(s), Publisher, Year, Page range of entry.
	Pearson, Kim Hai, and Brian Jennings. "Butler, Octavia E." <i>Encyclopedia of African-American Literature</i> , edited by Wilfred Samuels. Facts On File, 2013, pp. 24-34.
